#### PROBLEM:

## **UNABLE TO REMOVE FUEL FILLER CAP**

The customer complains that the fuel filler cap spins freely and cannot be removed from the fuel filler neck.

#### CAUSE:

Failure of the ratchet mechanism within the filler cap.

## ACTION:


Upon customer complaint of the above, use the following procedure to enable the filler cap to be removed without damage to the fuel filler neck.

- 1. Rotate the filler cap so that the orientation of the handbook symbol is as shown in the illustration, aligned with the lower edge of the filler neck.
- 2. Identify point at the base of the hand symbol, (arrowed in illustration) and mark with punch.
- 3. Carefully hand drill a 3mm hole at this point, TO A MAXIMUM DEPTH OF 10mm.



The hole must be no deeper than 10mm to avoid damage to the filler neck.

- Insert and tighten a self tapping screw. Use a pointed drive screw
  to 5mm diameter X 10mm maximum length.
- 5. The filler cap can now be removed in the usual way.
