# PROBLEM:

# REAR BRAKE SHOES STICKING ON

When the handbrake is released the rear brake shoes may stick to the brake drum.

### CAUSE:

Under certain conditions the brake shoe bonding material may cause the shoe to stick to the brake drum.

#### ACTION.

Where a customer complaint of the above is confirmed, replace the rear brake shoes set with a new specification set, now available from Land Rover Parts.
