All derivatives fitted with sub woofers up to VIN 2A 736340

PROBLEM:

TAIL DOOR VIBRATION

The tail door trim casing vibrates when the radio is operated at medium to high volume levels.

CAUSE:

Insufficient bonding between mating parts of the trim casing.

ACTION.

Where a complaint of the above is confirmed, replace the tail door trim casing with the new casing now available from Land Rover Parts.

Replace the tail door trim casing, refer to Workshop Manual, part number VDR100090, Doors, Trim Casing - Tail Door, repair number 76.34.09.99.
