## AFFECTED RANGE: All vehicles fitted with an Alpine radio

#### PROBLEM:

**RADIO SECURING CLIPS - BREAKING WHEN RADIO IS REMOVED** 


## CAUSE:

Incorrect tools have been used, or the correct tools have been used incorrectly.

### ACTION:

Read and understand fully the following procedure before removing the radio.

- 1. Insert radio removal keys, horizontally (shown in illustration 1), into the slots located at the top of the radio. Refer to tool information for part number detail.
- 2. Push the radio removal keys forwards horizontally, until a click is heard. This indicates that the radio removal keys are locked in position on the radio securing clips. NOTE: *If no force is felt between a radio removal key and the radio securing clip, then remove the key, and re-insert correctly.*
- Using the radio removal keys pull unit horizontally rearwards and remove from facia.
  NOTE: Only pull on the radio removal keys. Do not pull on the radio.
- 4. Remove the radio removal keys by pushing the radio securing clip down and pulling the radio removal keys out.
