AFFECTED RANGE:

All vehicles with occasional rear seats in VIN ranges: XA 900012 to XA 907212

XA 200412 to YA 290241

PROBLEM:

SCUFF MARKS ON OCCASIONAL REAR SEAT SQUAB (THIRD ROW)

The customer complains of damage to the squab cover adjacent to the seat belt buckle.


CAUSE:

Seat belt buckle remaining in raised position when seat is stowed.

ACTION:

Replace the inner squab hinge cover on both seats with modified covers incorporating a spring which automatically lowers the seat belt buckle. The new parts are now available in vehicle sets, refer to *PARTS INFORMATION*.

- 1. Pull off the squab release lever.
- 2. Remove the seat belt anchorage Torx bolt and remove buckle.
- 3. Remove the screw securing the hinge cover and remove cover.
- 4. Replace hinge cover with new cover from kit and secure with screw.
- 5. Obtain the appropriate return spring from the kit, (left hand illustrated) and engage with the seat belt buckle as shown at 'A'.



- 6. Refit seat belt buckle, locating the free end of the spring 'B', into hole 'C' in the hinge cover.
- 7. Apply lubricant such as STC4224 (Tefoil with PTFE spray) to the seat belt buckle pivot and anti-rattle washer.

- 8. Tighten the seat belt buckle Torx bolt to 32Nm.
- 9. Confirm that the seat belt buckle returns freely to the lower position when released.
- 10. Refit squab release lever.
- 11. Repeat for other seat.
