
## **Exploded View**












## How to replace the Back Lamp of LCD

Notes: Please order the parts as shown below, when replace the Back Lamp of LCD.

#### Back Light Ass'y Exchange process

- Disassembly of outside Tape / Cover shield
  - (1) Disassembly of Tape Adhesive used for fixing Top Case

Caution: Pressure or stress should not be given on Top Case during this process.


(2) Disassembly of Cover Shield-G

Caution: Pressure or stress should not be given on Top Case and Gate TCP.

(3) Disassembly of Cover Shield-S

Caution: Pressure or stress should not be given on Top Case and Source TCP.

It is recommended to use the Gloves with anti-eletric discharge coating for eliminating possible damage on circuits occurred by ESC.



- 2. Disassembly of Shield Tape, FPC, T/Case and Board Ass'y
  - (1) Disassembly of Tape Shield
  - (2) Disassembly of FPC

Caution: PCB pads at the soldering part should not be disconnected.

(3) Disassembly of Top Case

Caution: Pressure or stress should not be given on Top Case, Gate TCP and Source TCP.


(4) Disassembly of Source PCB

Caution: User Connector should be disconnected with pushing Source PCB upward.

(5) Disassembly of Board Ass'y after Gate PCB disassembly

Caution: Pressure or stress should not be given on PCB and TCP during disassembling Gate PCB from Supporter Main because there is double adhesive tape between Gate PCB and Supporter Main.

1 This process should be made in Clean Room with no scratch nor particle on Polarizer and B/L Ass'y.



- 3. Replace Back Light Ass'y with New Back Light ass'y
  - 1 This process should be made in Clean Room with no scratch nor particle on Polarizer and B/L Ass'y.
- 4. Assembly of Board Ass'y , T/Case, FPC and Shield Tape
  - (1) Assembly of Board Ass'y

Caution: Pressure or stress should not be given on PCB and TCP.

When assembling, there is no scratch nor particle on Polarizer and B/L Ass'y.

(2) Assembly of Source and Gate PCB.


Caution: Pressure or stress should not be given on PCB and TCP.

Before assembling the Gate PCB, remove the double adhesive tape on rear B/L Ass'y.

(3) Assembly of Top Case

Caution : Pressure or stress should not be given on TCP.

- (4) Assembly of FPC
- (5) Assembly of Tape shield.
  - 1 This process should be made in Clean Room with no scratch nor particle on Polarizer and B/L Ass'y.



### 5. Assembly of outside Tape / Cover shield

(1) Assembly of Cover shield-S

Caution : Pressure or stress should not be given on Gate TCP

(2) Assembly of Cover shield-G

Caution : Pressure or stress should not be given on Source TCP.
